## Women and Girls Fund of Waukesha County New Hope Scholarship and New Hope Trades Scholarship Applications now being accepted

WAUKESHA (October 15, 2018) – The Women and Girls Fund of Waukesha County is accepting applications for the 2019 New Hope Scholarship and 2019 New Hope Trades Scholarship awards. The purpose of the scholarships is to encourage and support women seeking a second chance at a better life through education by assisting in the elimination of the financial barrier of tuition.

The \$5,000 Women and Girls New Hope Scholarship and \$1,000 Women and Girls New Hope Trades Scholarship are available to help women achieve their educational goals. Requirements include applicants must be a female non-traditional student (25 years or older pursing post-secondary education for the first time or re-entering school) and a resident of Waukesha County.
