**Women and Girls Fund of Waukesha County is seeking grant applications**

WAUKESHA (December 13, 2018) – The Women and Girls Fund of Waukesha County (WGF) is accepting grant letters of intent for 2019. The WGF will award grants up to \$15,000 each for selected program/projects.

The WGF, established in 2004, seeks to aid and enrich the lives of women and girls so they become thriving residents of their communities. Each year, the Women and Girls Fund of Waukesha County awards grants to local nonprofit agencies to support projects and programs that promote women and girls of all ages. Focus areas include **health, education, well-being and empowerment**.

In 2018, the WGF awarded over \$90,000 to 10 local non-profit organizations. Since its inception, the Fund has granted nearly \$900,000 to countywide nonprofit organizations. Letters of Intent for 2019 grants are due in the WGF office by 4 pm on Friday, January 18, 2019. Applicants may submit a letter of intent for more than one program/project. Applicants will be notified if selected to submit a full grant proposal by Thursday, January 31, 2019.
